My comments are brief. My main concern is the lack of segregated, maintained cycle paths on this proposal. After availing of the free cycle training offered before the launch of the Belfast bike scheme, using advance stop lines and bus lanes is really inadequate for the less experienced commuting cyclist especially on busier routes.
